

## ICS 201 - Camp Arroyo Grande Fire

Incident Number: SLU 10230 TBD by ECC

Time: First unit at scene time (5 MIN)

Map or Sketch: Cabins at Camp Arroyo Grande. Creek on the south side as a potential anchor. Limited access roads. Light flashy fuels with scattered oak understory. Draw containment box on map: keep fire north of creek, south of Hilltop cabins, east of Mercedes Lane, west of Oak Ridge.

Initial Size Up and Report on Conditions:

- Fire size: approx. 1-5 acres in grass/light brush
- ROS: moderate, upslope toward cabins
- Potential: 50-100 acres with winds increasing from west
- Life threat: campers/staff
- Property threat: cabins, camp infrastructure
- Hazards: power lines, narrow roads, bridge load limits
- Access: Old Ranch Rd via Mercedes Ln
- Command: Camp AG IC established

Hold control lines around the box</li><li>4. Keep fire N of creek, S of Hilltop cabins, E of Mercedes Ln, W of Oak Ridge</li><li>5. No injuries</li></ol>	<p>Current Actions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Type 1 engines on structure protection</li><li>- Type 3 engine anchoring at creek</li><li>- Establish LCES</li><li>- Coordinate evacuation</li></ul>

Time: First unit at scene time

Map or Sketch: Steep hillside behind 1005 Meadow Way. Structures at top. Draw box: keep fire N of lower greenbelt, S of ridge homes, E of Oak Knoll spur, W of east drainage.

Initial Size Up and ROC:

- Fire size: 3-8 acres grass/brush
- ROS: dangerous, wind-driven upslope
- Potential: 150-300 acres
- Life threat: ridge homes
- Property threat: ornamental vegetation
- Hazards: limited hydrants, overhead lines
- Access: James Way to Meadow Way
- Command: James IC established

Time: First unit at scene time

Map or Sketch: Canyon behind 598 Via La Barrantca, MTZ. Homes both sides. Draw box: N of lower trail, S of ridge road, E of west spur, W of utility corridor.

Initial Size Up and ROC:

- Fire size: 5-10 acres chaparral
- ROS: mod/dangerous, 10-15 mph NW winds
- Potential: 300+ acres
- Life threat: canyon rim residents
- Property threat: dense housing both sides
- Hazards: power lines, narrow access
- Access: MTZ preplan points
- Command: Unified Command planned

<b>Incident Objectives:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Activate MTZ preplan</li><li>2. Protect life &amp; structures both sides</li><li>3. Hold within box by 2000</li><li>4. Air/ground coordinated attack</li><li>5. No injuries</li></ol>	<b>Current Actions:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Div A west: Type 3 + dozer</li><li>- Div B east: hand crew + Type 3</li><li>- Structure Group: Type 1s both rims</li><li>- Air Attack w/ tanker &amp; helicopter</li></ul>

Winds, ember cast, power lines, anchor before upslope
